2026-27 SEASON

Age Groups & Registration

This year, youth soccer age classifications changed from birth-year to school-year classifications. As a result, some players moved up an age group, while others remained in the same group as last season. We made every effort to keep existing teams together while creating balanced rosters that support player development, appropriate playing time, and each team's long-term growth.

All players must complete online registration. This is separate from the returning-player preregistration form for August or November start dates; preregistration alone does not register your player for the season.

Returning players have been sent the official GotSport registration link through PlayMetrics. Invited new players will receive the link directly by email or text.

NOVEMBER START

School Soccer Players

Players finishing a school soccer season may register now and join Legacy FC in November. They will not be rostered until their school season ends. Registering early helps us prepare their paperwork in time for club events.

Training, Games & Events

Training sessions will begin the week of August 10. Teams will have at least two scheduled training sessions per week, typically ranging from 90 minutes to two hours each. Team-specific details - including coaching assignments, practice schedules, and other important information - will be shared with families as they are finalized.

Players can expect several games and events throughout the fall and spring seasons, including in-state league play, in-state tournaments - including our own Appalachian Champions Cup in the spring - and regional travel tournament weekends.

Our standard schedule typically includes one tournament weekend per month during the fall and spring seasons. Common travel destinations include Charleston, Barboursville, Bridgeport, and Morgantown, West Virginia; Gatlinburg, Kingsport, and Knoxville, Tennessee; Cary, Greensboro, and Winston-Salem, North Carolina; and Blacksburg, Roanoke, and Richmond, Virginia.

During the winter months, indoor programming will include training sessions, league play, and tournament events.

Select older teams should also plan for State Cup and postseason events next summer. Dates will be shared as they become available.

PlayMetrics will continue to serve as our centralized app for team communication, scheduling, and billing management. New families will receive an email invitation to join PlayMetrics after completing registration.

It is very important that families update their players' availability in PlayMetrics for all training sessions, games, and team events as soon as they are posted. This allows coaches and team managers to plan and prepare efficiently. Please also make sure your contact information and PlayMetrics notification settings are current so you don't miss any updates.
